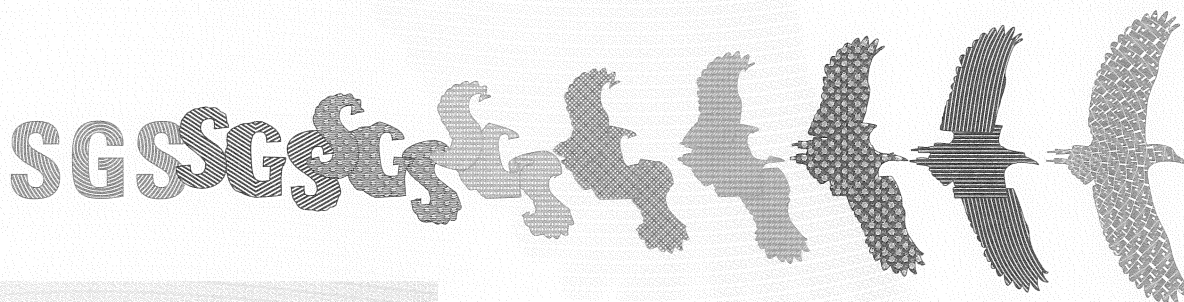

- a) S.Tec (logo) EN ENFORCER H Rope Access Systems Rope Adjustment Device with a stainless steel body and a stainless steel cam.
- b) S.Tec (logo) EN ENFORCER L Rope Access Systems Rope Adjustment Device with a stainless steel body and an orange anodized aluminium cam.

These models must only be used as part of a rope access safety line (back-up) system and attached before use to a compatible low stretch (10.5 mm to 11 mm dia.) kernmantle rope, as detailed in the manufacturer's user information.

It is certified that the manufacturer's technical file and the above mentioned PPE have been assessed and found to be in accordance with the requirements of Council Directive 89/686/EEC. When examined the PPE satisfied the requirements in the relevant harmonized standard:

EN 12841:2006 (Rope access systems - rope adjustment devices) for Type A rope adjustment devices: safety line adjustment device with a maximum rated load of 100 kg.
